


THE SCOSTS



- ► For-profit schools are **expensive**—they tend to cost **twice** as much as public institutions.
- Because it costs so much, the average amount of debt for students at a for-profit school is 3x higher than at a public school!

THE EDUCATION



- ► Of students in bachelor's programs at for-profit schools, only **a third** will graduate.
- Depending on the program, only half of those who do graduate will secure a job because for-profit programs do not prepare their students to be successful in their chosen fields.

THE PROBLEM

For-profit schools in Maryland are becoming increasingly dangerous to low-income students. Each year, thousands of Maryland students enroll in these schools with the hopes of improving their situation by securing better jobs to support themselves and their families. These schools are highly effective at attracting students by marketing on television, but these for-profit schools do not always live up to their promises...
